

National Insurance Coverage

Each UCI / CCA/Citizen licensee has access to:

- \$5M 3rd Party Liability insurance plus Sport Excess Medical insurance; this includes the popular benefits such as Ambulance transport, physiotherapy, fractures, prescription eyeglasses incurred within 52 weeks of date of accident
- Insurance coverage is not 24-hr coverage; team and club members are covered during their respectively registered team and club activities as listed each affiliate's application form and during events sanctioned by the CCA and Cycling BC
- Team and Club Members have 30 days to report an injury if an accident occurs while participating in their respectively registered team and club activities
- Bikes, Riding Equipment and/or Personal Belongings are not covered by this policy

Coach's & Organizer's Insurance

This is the same policy as rider insurance, but while the member is working in a technical role (coach, instructor, organizer, manager, mechanic, or driver). Some technical licenses require certification (i.e. NCCP or CBC Prov C Commissaire Levels) and a code of conduct must be signed.

Director's & Officer's Insurance

This is a separate policy which provides coverage in the case of wrongful decision-making

- * Policy runs from March 1st to April 30th
- * Applications are requested from our office
- * Most Common Example: a club member is disgruntled regarding a decision made by the club's executive

2011 Affiliation Types

Provincial Trade Team

Trade Teams are privately owned entities with self-selected memberships. On-site race support is often provided to members including coaching, technical and managerial services. Trade Teams organize races, training activities & social events either for its own members, members of other clubs, teams or UCI/CCA license holders.

Affiliated Club

Affiliated clubs are not-for-profit groups that have a minimum of three directors / board members, a set of by-laws and a constitution. Each member must be insured and hold a current UCI/CCA or citizen license, or an associate club membership. The club exists to organize cycling events for its members, has an open membership and belongs to members.

Supporting Business

Supporting Businesses are registered organizations or business entities that sponsor select riders, but don't manage the responsibility of an open club. On-site race support is not given and therefore may not assign a team manager or coach. Affiliation is only recognized in BC and not included in the national insurance program.
