National Insurance Coverage

Each UCI / CCA licensee has access to:

- \$5M 3rd Party Liability insurance plus Sport Excess Medical insurance; this includes the popular benefits such as Ambulance transport, physiotherapy, fractures, prescription eyeglasses incurred within 52 weeks of date of accident
- Insurance coverage is not 24-hr coverage; as a club member and race license holder, a member is covered during registered club activities as listed on your club's affiliation form and during events sanctioned by the CCA and Cycling BC
- Club members have 30 days to report an injury if an accident occurs while participating in registered club activities
- Bikes, Riding Equipment and/or Personal Belongings are not covered by this policy

Coach's & Organizer's Insurance

This is the same policy as rider insurance, but while the member is working in a technical role (coach, instructor, organizer, manager, mechanic, or driver). Some technical licenses require certification (i.e. NCCP or CBC Prov C Commissaire Levels) and a code of conduct must be signed.

Director's & Officer's Insurance

This is a separate policy which provides coverage in the case of wrongful decision-making

- * Policy runs from March 1st to April 30th
- * Applications are requested from our office
- * Most Common Example: a team member is disgruntled regarding a decision made by the team's executive



Out of Country Insurance

(club members racing outside Canada)

- It is highly recommended that all team members purchase additional out of country medical while training/competing outside of the country in approved activities.
- The insurance provided with a UCI/CCA license is NOT valid outside of Canada
- The rate is \$5 /day and must be arranged through the office

Definition—Provincial Club:

- Operates as a not-for-profit group
- Has a minimum of 3 on Board of Directors
- Has a set of by-laws and a constitution
- Insures all members with minimum of
 - affiliated club member
 - citizen license holder (RACE LICENSE)
 - uci/cca license holder (RACE LICENSE)

Definition—continued:

- Organizes Road, Track, CX, BMX, DH & XC events
- Welcomes new members and does not restrict membership like a provincial trade team
- Belongs to the members; does not belong to a business or individual
- Has at least 5 riders who are part of the general membership who also hold a race license
