

2017 Canada Summer Games MTB Team Selection Criteria

Location: Winnipeg, QC
Dates: July 27th – August 5th, 2017
Description: Event format will have racers competing in the XCO, Relay and Sprint
Team Composition: 3 males and 3 females¹

Project Details:

The project will run from August 5-13th, inclusive of travel days. The project fee will range be \$250 and will include flights, luggage fees, ground transportation for all events, race support, cycling kit, casual wear, all meals, and accommodation. The accommodation will be at the University of Manitoba and healthy meals will be provided through the campus cafeteria. Athletes are responsible for their preferred race and recovery food.

Race Format:

XCO: 1h30	Sprint: 1 lap
Relay: Team of 4, 1 lap each	

Selection Date: Notification of selection to the team will be made by mid July 2017.

Eligibility: To be eligible for selection to the team athletes must:

- All 2017 Cycling BC Targeted Athletes who meet the following eligibility requirements are automatically entered into the long list pool
- Possess a current Cycling BC License
- Born between: 1995-2001 (those born in 2001 will need to request an upgrade)

Selection Criteria:

Athletes will be selected subjectively and objectively by points (1 males/females objectively and 2 males/females subjectively). Selection will be made as follows:

Points will be earned in the following races**:

1. **Selection Camp: April 15/16th**
 - a. **This camp is open to all athletes and will include mock races, mental training seminars, and much more. More information, including a link to register will be released Mid March.**
2. Chain Line Classic, Kelowna – April 30th
3. Provincial Championships: June 24th
4. **Selection Camp: Late June/Early July** (This camp is open to athletes who have participated in at least one selection event, more info. on the format of the final selection camp will be available early March)

**For each race riders will be ranked 1-10 in the U17 (2nd year cadets only), U19 and Elite (U23 only) category. Meaning there will be first place, second place, third place, etc. points awarded to each of the two categories.

¹ Cycling BC reserves the right to increase or decrease the team size based on available resources



Points can only be obtained in Expert Men/Women and will be awarded as indicated in Table 1. Ties will be broken by the number of 1st place finishes, 2nd place finishes, 3rd place finishes, etc.
