



# 2019 Tour de Beauce Selection Criteria

**Location:** Beauce, QC  
**Dates:** June 19<sup>th</sup> – June 23<sup>rd</sup>  
**Description:** Event format will have racers competing in the RR, TT and Crit.  
**Team Composition:** 5-7 males  
**Coaches:** TBD

## Project Details:

The project will run from June 25<sup>th</sup> – July 2<sup>nd</sup>, inclusive of travel days and is a development project for U21 athletes. The project fee will range from ~ \$1200-\$1500 and will include ground transportation for all events, to/from airport, grocery shopping trips, race support, cycling kit, and accommodation. Athletes are responsible for flights, luggage, all meals and preferred race and recovery food.

## Race Format (based on 2018 Race info):

Stage 1: 177km  
Stage 2: 169km  
Stage 3A: 20km ITT  
Stage 3B: 77km  
Stage 4: 70km Crit  
Stage 5: 122km Circuit

**Selection Date:** Notification of selection to the team will be made after the Cascade Classic.

**Eligibility:** To be eligible for selection to the team athletes must:

- Possess a current Cycling BC License
- U23 Athletes (priority will be given to U21 athletes)

## Selection Criteria:

Athletes will be selected subjectively and objectively by points (up to 3 males objectively and up to 4 males subjectively).

- Athletes **MUST** race in **CAT 1/2**

Selection will be made as follows:

Points will be earned in the following races:

Points will be earned in the following races:

1. BC Provincial RR and TT Championships: May 25-26<sup>th</sup>, 2019, Langely
2. Cascade Classic: May 29<sup>th</sup> – June 2<sup>nd</sup>, Oregon

Points will be awarded over the two/three races to rank riders. For example:

Points can only be obtained in CAT 3 Men and 3 Women and will be awarded as indicated in Table 1. Ties will be broken by the number of 1<sup>st</sup> place finishes, 2<sup>nd</sup> place finishes, 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishes, etc.
