

## PROTEST / APPEAL DOCUMENT Cycling BC

**Protests** must be filed and signed by the Protester and submitted to the Head Commissaire within 30 minutes of the event ending. **Appeals** must be submitted by the Appellant to <a href="mailto:races@cyclingbc.net">races@cyclingbc.net</a> no later than 24 hours of the event ending.

A **protest** is a formal complaint against the conduct of a fellow athlete or race official, or against conditions of the competition. An **appeal** is a request for a review of a decision made by Commissaire or Event Organizer. This is the first level of appeal and will be heard by Cycling BC Management. Unofficial result questions should be addressed to Commissaire or Event Organiser within 30 minutes of results being posted (generally, the period before results become official).

To submit a protest or appeal, you must have substantial evidence, including witnesses, and you must be willing to take part in an interview. All appeals/protests must be accompanied with a cheque or cash for \$25. If your protest is upheld as valid, the fee will be returned to you.
