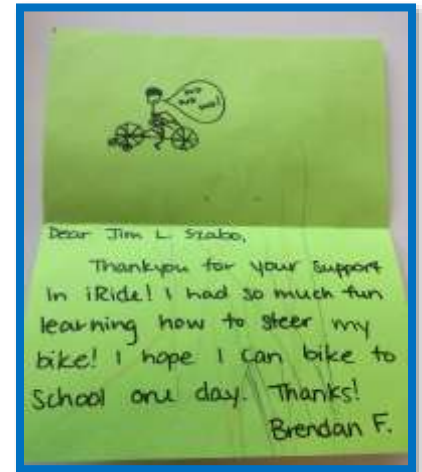
What the donors love to hear about:

Here are a few samples and ideas:

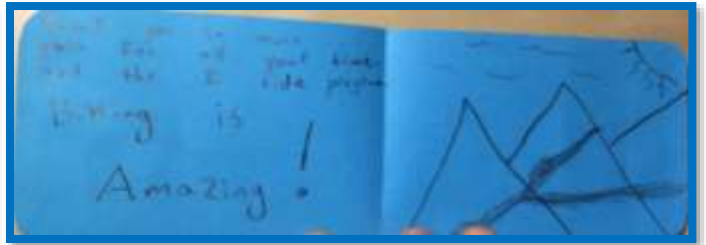
A) Small Card – Vertical

- 8.5x11" paper, cut into 4 even pieces = 4.5x5.5".
- Fold vertically -> 4.5x2.75"



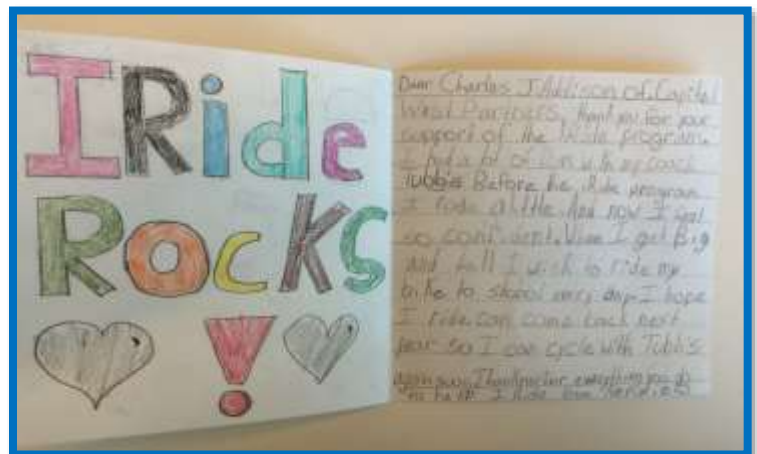
B) Small Card - Horizontal

- 8.5x11" paper, cut into 4 even stripes = 8.5x2.75".
- Fold horizontally -> 4.5x2.75"



C) Medium Card – Horizontal

- 8.5x5" paper.
- Fold horizontally -> 4.25x5"
