



2019 Jr. Road Nationals Team Selection Criteria

Location: Beauce, QC
Dates: June 25th – July 2nd, 2019 (incl. travel days)
Description: Event format will have racers competing in the RR, TT and Crit.
Team Composition: 4 males and 4 females¹
Coaches: Houshang Amiri & Brandon Archer

Project Details:

The project will run from June 25th – July 2nd, inclusive of travel days. The project fee will range from \$500-\$600 and will include ground transportation for all events, to/from airport, grocery shopping trips, race support, cycling kit, and accommodation. Athletes are responsible for flights, luggage, all meals and preferred race and recovery food.

Race Format (based on 2018 Race info):

RR: Male 133km, Female 74km	Crit: 1.4 km Men 30 laps, Women 22 laps
TT: Male 28km, Female 14km	

Selection Date: Notification of selection to the team will be made after the Hayman Classic and Cycling Canada Talent ID Camp

Eligibility: To be eligible for selection to the team athletes must:

- Possess a current Cycling BC License
- Born between: 2001-2003 (those born in 2003 will need to request an upgrade to Jr.)

Selection Criteria:

Athletes will be selected subjectively and objectively by points (2 males/females objectively and 2 males/females subjectively).

- Athletes **MUST** race in **CAT 3**²
- Athletes **MUST** race/ride in **JUNIOR GEARING** for Hayman Classic.

Selection will be made as follows:

Points will be earned in the following races:

Points will be earned in the following races:

1. EV Spring Classic/BC Cup: April 6th
 - a. This race is an objective race, where results only will be utilized
2. EV Spring Stage Race: May 11/12
 - a. This race is an objective race, where results only will be utilized
3. Hayman Classic, Penticton: May 24th – 26th
 - a. This race is an objective and subjective race, where results and evaluation of athlete's skill and tactics will be utilized

Points will be awarded over the two/three races to rank riders. For example:

Points can only be obtained in CAT 3 Men and 3 Women and will be awarded as indicated in Table 1. Ties will be broken by the number of 1st place finishes, 2nd place finishes, 3rd place finishes, etc.
