

## **Coach Development Grants**

Cycling BC members can apply for grants to help attend NCCP modules and pursue certified status. Once certified, coach development grants can also help Cycling BC members pursue non-NCCP professional development opportunities.

There are  $\underline{\text{five}}$  grants available each calendar year. Cycling BC members in good standing can apply after December 1<sup>st</sup>. Applications are reviewed and awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Successful applicants register for their coach training modules at cyclingbc.net/coachreg and pay the total price. Once an applicant's final training module is complete, submit a post-event report within 14 days to receive 50% reimbursement up to a \$250 annual maximum.

Post-event reports help Cycling BC ensure your coach training experience was helpful and share your story with our general membership. Reports include 3-5 high-quality images, an invoice (using a provided template) with scanned receipts, and a 2-3 paragraph report about the experience.

Written paragraphs should answer the following questions:

- What training modules did you attend, and how did it go?
- What was the most significant learning outcome? *The lightbulb moment*.
- How could the training and certification process be improved?
