



2022 Canada Summer Games Road Team Selection Criteria

Location: Niagara Falls, ON
Dates: August 15-21st, 2022
Description: Event format will have racers competing in the RR, TT and Crit.
Team Composition: 4 males and 4 females, 1 wildcard (can be male or female)¹

Project Details:

The project will run from August 15-21st, inclusive of travel days. The project fee will be \$250 and will include flights, luggage fees, ground transportation for all events, race support, cycling kit, casual wear, all meals, and accommodation. The accommodation will be at Brock University and healthy meals will be provided through the campus cafeteria. Athletes are responsible for their preferred race and recovery food.

Race Format:

RR: Male 120km, Female 80km	Crit: Men 50km, Women 40km
TT: Male 20-25km, Female 10-15km	

Selection Date: Notification of selection to the team will be made by end of July (date will be confirmed after the selection camp date is confirmed).

Eligibility:

- Submit a letter of interest to Tara (tara@cyclingbc.net) by April 15th.
- All 2022 Cycling BC Targeted Athletes who meet the following eligibility requirements are automatically entered into the long list pool
- Possess a current Cycling BC License
- Born between 2001 – 2006 (ages 16-21 by December 31st, 2022)
- Athletes excluded from the Canada Summer games are:
 - Senior national team members (SR, SR1, SR2 or C1 card at any time or on the roster of a standing national team.
 - Athletes who have previously competed at the following events:
 - More than one U23 UCI World Championships (road/MTB)
 - More than one Elite UCI World Championships (Track)
 - Olympic Games, Commonwealth Games and Pan Games

¹ Cycling BC reserves the right to decrease the team size based on available resources.

Selection Criteria:

Athletes will be selected subjectively and objectively by points (2 males/females objectively and 2 males/females and 1 wildcard subjectively). Athletes MUST race in **CAT 2**² except for Road Provincial Championships and National Championships where athletes MUST race in their UCI designated Category (U17, Jr, U23, Elite). Selection will be made as follows:

Points will be earned in the following races:

1. Aldergrove/Atomic RR: April 16th
2. Road Provincial Championships: May 28th
3. TT Provincial Championships: May 29th
4. Road National Championships: June 21-26th
5. *Selection Camp* (This camp is open to all riders looking to make the CSG team – but riders must've taken part in AT LEAST 1 of the selection road events to be asked to come. More info. on the format of the final selection camp will be available in ...)

Points will be awarded over the two races to rank riders. For example:

**For each race riders will be ranked 1-10 in the U17 (2nd year cadets only), U19 and Elite (U23 only) category. Meaning there will be first place, second place, third place, etc. points awarded to each of the two categories.

Points can only be obtained in CAT 2 Men and Women unless otherwise stated and will be awarded as indicated in Table 1. Ties will be broken by the number of 1st place finishes, 2nd place finishes, 3rd place finishes, etc.

² Athletes racing in CAT 3 will be considered subjectively, if a TT is the same distance as CAT 2, the CAT 3's will be included in the points.
