Event Overview

Cycling BC, and Whistler Blackcomb are proud to present the first stop of the BC Cup. This race will be held in Whistler, British Columbia.

This Technical Guide covers the relevant rules and procedures for BC Cup event held on June 25 & 26, 2022. In case of a divergence between the information found within this Technical Guide and information concerning these events found anywhere else, this Technical Guide shall be considered correct. The 2022 BC Cup Series rules also form an integral part of this document; they should be consulted together with this Technical Guide. The procedures within that document applicable to all 2022 BC Cup events shall apply equally to these events. The 2022 BC Cup Series rules are available on Cycling BC's website.

Participation and Sanctioning

By registering for this event, racers agree to follow and be bound by the rules and procedures outlined in the Technical Guide, and also agree to follow the rules of the International Cycling Union (UCI), Cycling Canada, and Cycling British Columbia. Likewise, the policies, rules and procedures of the Whistler Mountain Bike Park apply when participating on Whistler Blackcomb property.

- Registration for BC Cup categories requires the presentation of a valid BC or UCI race license.
- Single Event Licenses will be available at registration for non-cup categories.
- Pre-register to avoid disappointment, **no race day registration will be available.**
- If there are less than 3 riders in a class, one or more categories may be combined. If 1 or more categories are combined, points are allocated to each rider based on how they would place in their regular category. However, the podium will be based on the combined category result

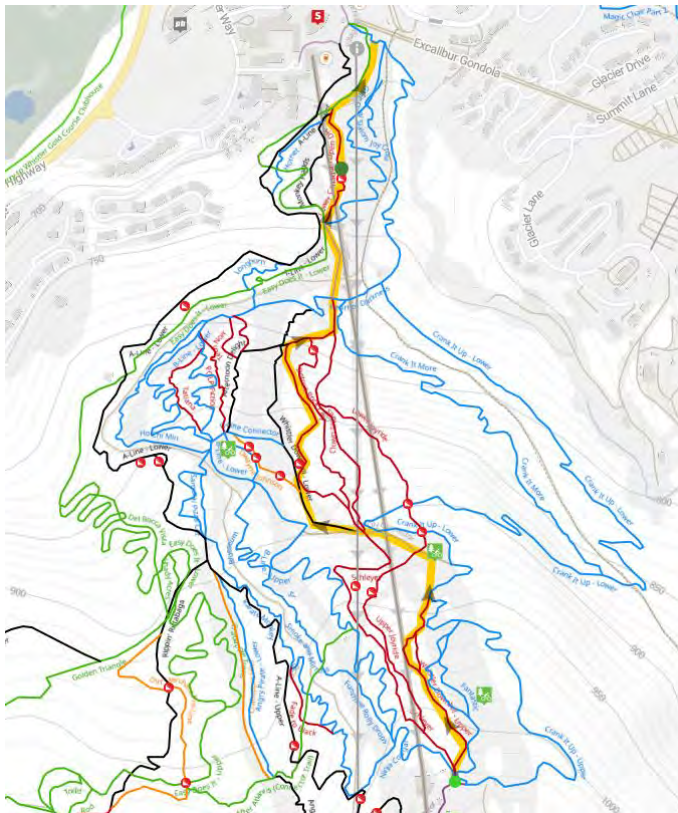

Race Numbers and Timing

- Race plates will be distributed at sign-in/ plate pick up.
- The race will be timed by the timing company recommended by Cycling BC.
- Numbers must not be folded or modified without the permission of the President of the Commissaries Panel and must clearly show all advertising.
- Numbers must be completely visible at all times during the race and training.





Results

- Seeding results will be posted on the hut windows at the bottom of the GLC Stairs.
- Race results will be posted on the results board in the finish area during the race.
Official results will be posted within 24 hours on <https://www.whistlerblackcomb.com/explore-the-resort/activities-and-events/whistler-mountain-bike-park/plan-your-ride/events.aspx>
- Please allow 30 minutes for times to be posted after the last racer has finished.
- There will be a 15 minute window to allow for results claims.

Awards/Podiums

- There will be awards ceremonies for each race. All podium finishers are expected to be in attendance.
- Awards will be held in the finish immediately post-race.

Staging and Start Protocol

- For Pro/Elite Men/Women and Junior Expert Men and Junior Women, as this is the first race of the season, the 2021 final BC Cup standings will be used to determine the start order for the seeding run, others will be ranked randomly. Top rank start last.
- The race start order will be the reverse order from the seeding run results.
- For all other categories, plates will be assigned for pre-registered riders only based on 2021 BC Cup series standings. Others will be assigned randomly. The start will be in reverse order from plate number (most points start last).

Warm-Up/Pre-Riding the Course

- Warming up on the course while a race is in progress, or at any other unauthorized time, is strictly prohibited and will result in disqualification.
- Helmets must be worn AT ALL TIMES when riding the course and failure to comply will result in disqualification.

Equipment

- UCI, Cycling Canada and Cycling BC rules apply. It is the responsibility of all riders to know these rules.
- Riders are required to wear club or team jerseys corresponding to their license.
- Independent riders are required to wear a jersey with no significant logos, team names or advertising displayed on them.
- Sleeveless jerseys are not permitted.
- All lycra-elastane based tight-fitting clothing is not permitted.
- The use of glass containers is strictly prohibited.
- Bicycle helmets are required to be worn by riders on or off the course at ALL times when riding a bike.



Mandatory Protective Equipment:

- U16 (15 and Under)
 - As per UCI/CC/Cycling BC rules: Full face helmet with peak
 - As per Whistler Mountain Bike Park: knee pads, elbow pads, gloves.
- Adults (16+)
 - As per UCI/CC/Cycling BC rules: Full Face Helmet with peak

Cameras

- The use of camera will be allowed during training but prohibited during seeding and racing.
- The riders are responsible for securing the fixation of the cameras in order to avoid any danger.

Inclement Weather

- Race held rain, snow, or shine
- In the event of unsafe weather (e.g., lightning) on race day, race officials may delay or cancel racing

Pits

- There will be limited Pit Space located next to the Blackcomb Excalibur Gondola, across the village walkway from the Dublin Gate Pub.
- Tents must be 10'x10' and all 4 legs must be weighted down. -There is no vehicle access to the pits.
- Pit space is first come first serve. There is room for approx. 7 or 8 tents in the zone.

Parking

Parking is available in the day lots. Lots 1-5 are Pay Parking. -Lots 6 & 7 are free. Please note there will be limited parking available in the upper lots. Lot 8 is not available for parking.

Doping Control



Cycling Canada's RaceClean program aims to address and recognize the importance of fair play, clean sport, and the obligation racers have to compete within the rules. It is our hope that all Canadian athletes respect the rules which include not using prohibited substances or practices. There is no official doping control plan for this event, however unannounced control is always a possibility. Riders will be met at the finish line by a chaperone should testing take place.
